POLKA DOT BLOCK

Materials Required

White Fabric (preferably white dot)

4 Coloured polka dot fabrice

Cutting Instructions for Block


8 - white 3" squares


2 - 3" squares of each of the 4 colours


2 - 2" squares of each of the 4 colours

Block Assembly using 1/4" seams

Draw diagonal line on each of the 2" dot squares. Place 2" square on corner of white 3" square. Stitch on marked line; trim and press seams open. Make 2 of each colour.








Then sew blocks together with like colours for each block as follows: Polka Dot 3" square with white/polka dot 3" square White/polka dot 3" square with polka dot 3" square


Sew rows together to make Bow Tie Block - 5 1/2 " Square



Sew together 4-5%" blocks to make a 10%" block.
